INFORMATION FOR SCOUTS





The Chief Scout will be making a short visit to Peel in the Isle of Man, on Saturday 11. May 2013. All Island Scouts are invited to an afternoon of activities and have the chance to see the Chief Scout.

Scouts are to assemble in the area located in the photo on the left for no later than 12:30. Car Parking is available in the field as shown. Scouts will then do a Treasure Hunt through Peel (in groups of three), which will lead them to Fenella Beach, where they will spend a couple of hours doing activities in the closed off Car Park, Fenella Bay and the Headland.

Some of these activities are on the water, so please check out the personal equipment box below of what you need to bring.

During the activities the Chief Scout will be passing through the activity area, please note there will be no time for autographs – *sorry*.

Activities finish at 15:00 and all Scouts will be taken back up to the car park for collection by parents at 15:30.

Parents Note: The Fenella Car Park, will be closed off and restricted to Scouts only. If you wish to see the Chief Scout, the best place to view will be on the promenade, watching as he visits the Beaver Scout and Cub Scout area, which will be in a roped off part of the beach.

This event will be going ahead whatever the weather. As the Chief Scout is arriving by helicopter, his attendance may be weather dependent.
