## DUSK TILL DAWN HIKE



All Island Scouts and Explorer Scouts are invited to take part in the Island Dusk Till Dawn Hike, which is taking place over the 13. – 14. July 2012. The idea of the activity is to hike on Friday night from Glen Maye to Ballasalla along the Bayr Ny Skeddán, catch a few hours sleep in Malew Hall, have breakfast and complete the hike at the Square in Castletown on Saturday morning.



Everyone who completes the Dusk Till Dawn Hike will be presented with the specially produced badge (see above) which can be worn on uniform, alongside other activity badges.

Scouts should turn up at Glen Maye with a daysac containing an evening snack, waterproofs, working torch. They will also need a separate bag containing overnight kit of sleeping bag, roll mat, wash kit and mess kit. This will be transported to Ballasalla and the next morning to Castletown. Each group of Scout walkers will need a Leader with them. Explorer Scouts can walk on their own at the discretion of their Leaders.

### ***Timing Details:***

#### **Friday 13. July 2012**

**20:00** Arrive at Glen Maye (*Waterfall Pub Car Park*). Register in, equipment check and head off along the Bayr Ny Skeddán to Ballasalla. Sleeping Kit will be transported from Glen Maye to Ballasalla.

#### **Saturday 14. July 2012**

**00:30 – 01:30** Arrive at Malew Hall, Ballasalla. Settle down for the night.

**07:30 – 08:15** Breakfast and pack Sleeping Kit away ready for it to be transported to Castletown.

**08:30** Hike to Castletown along the Bayr Ny Skeddán.

**09:30 – 10:00** Finish Hike at Castletown Square. As hikers finish they will be presented with their Dusk Till Dawn Badges.
