A bobble type hat is better than a baseball hat as it can be pulled down to cover the ears. Plastic bags are for putting used clothing in. It is a good idea to line your rucsac with a strong bin liner as this will protect you kit from getting damp.

Please ensure that <u>all items</u> have the owners name clearly marked on them. At the end of camp we always seem to have literally dozens of items which are not claimed and are difficult if not impossible to return to the correct owners as there is no identification on them.
